MEALTIMES

Breakfast: 06:45

Lunch: 13:50

Supper: 17:45 (Due to catechism, supper on Mondays is at 17:30)

(Meal times may be adjusted accordingly during tests/exams/tours, etc.)

STUDY TIMES

Monday to Thursday: Session from 18:30 to 19:30

Session from 19:45 to 20:30

"Appel" 21:00 to 21:15

During the exams there will be an extra study session in the mornings and afternoons. Nobody will be allowed to make or take calls during study sessions.

BELLS

The Teacher on Duty will ring the **rising bell** (electric bell) at **06:00**. Everybody must then be out of their beds.

The House Committee is responsible for the ringing of all the other bells, which will be rung punctually:

1. **SILENCE** at 06:30.
2. All beds must be made and the room swept and ready for inspection at 06:30.
3. The breakfast bell rings at 06:40. Everyone must then be ready and lined up in their queues. No excuses for not being on time or being absent.
4. Lunch is directly after school comes out for the day at 13:50.
5. After lunch it is SILENCE from 14h30 to 14h15. During test and exams this time is replaced with STUDY.
6. At 15:30 the "afgaan"-bell is rung. Everybody must then be out of their rooms and out of the hostel.

Only in exceptional cases, and with the necessary permission of a Teacher or Prefect, may a boy return to fetch something from his room during this time. No loafing around is permitted in the hostel.

If matron took a boy to a doctor and the boy has been booked off, he does not have to leave his room.

7. At 16:45 the "opgaan" (going up)-bell is rung: Boys are allowed to re-enter the hostel in order to shower and dress for supper and study.

- ❖ The shower bell rings as follows: Mondays at 17:00; Rest of the week at 17:15
- ❖ Boys who were unable to take a shower will have another opportunity to do so after study.

8. Supper is at 17h45 with exception to Mondays supper is at 17:30.

Dress code for supper is the school tracksuit. During summer learners may remove the top and wear their "bell shirts" (Grey golf shirt). This must be neatly tucked in, and no slops are permitted in the dining hall.

After supper, boys are expected to play outside until study time. They are not allowed to enter their rooms during this time.

9. The bell for "appèl" (roll call) rings at 20h55 to start at 21h00

The bell for silence rings at 21:40, and all lights must be out at 22:00. These times may be adjusted by the Teacher on Duty, depending on the duration of "appèl" (roll call).

10. Boys who require late study need to obtain the necessary permission from the Teacher on Duty.

"Lights out" for late study is at 23:00.

11. The hostel needs to be absolutely quiet after lights out and no loafing around is permitted. Any boy who uses his phone 15 minutes after lights out will forfeit his phone for 7 days.
